We are asking you to do the Summer Shift. No, it's not a new dance. The Summer Shift is when you voluntarily reduce electricity use between the hours of 11 a.m. and 7 p.m. on weekdays. Demand for electricity is high during that time and costly. Shifting electricity use to outside that timeframe or conserving electricity helps keep electricity affordable. Do the Summer Shift by turning up the thermostat a few degrees, delaying the dishwasher or shifting the start of laundry.
